1 - Age to be taken as at 1st June, 2011.

2 - All entries to be registered or eligible for registration in the Herd Book of the respective Breed Society.

3 - All exhibits must be on the grounds no later than 7.30am on Saturday.

**4 - All bulls over 12 months must be led with a nose ring, all other cattle to be led with nose grip.**

5 - No Stud beef cattle will be admitted to the grounds unless thoroughly tractable

6 - All cattle to remain on the showgrounds until after the completion of the Grand Parade.

7 - Any animal shown as an individual exhibit may not be shown with its dam.

8 - Breeds to be judged separately within their classes.

9 - All leads and electrical equipment to be tested and tagged in accordance with safety regulations.

10 - All exhibitors must carry their own Public Liability Insurance
