WOODFORD SHOWGROUNDS CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- This form to be completed before going onto site. Please camp where Caretakers have directed.
- **Duration of stay – 7-night stay MAX** – 7-days out policy – as per MBRC Guidelines. Emergency situations ONLY please contact Woodford A. P. & I Assoc. Inc. regarding any extended stay.
- **NO TENTS OR SWAGS**
- All fees to be paid on arrival – Fees available on Woodford show Web page and Caretakers office.
- Woodford Showgrounds is under 24/7 video surveillance.
- Departure by 10am on your last day
- **Respect** – Your fellow campers, report any suspicious behaviors. Failure to follow rules will result in immediate eviction with no warning or refund given.
- The registered occupant of the site is responsible for all members and guests of their party.
- Vehicle Registration – all vehicles to be registered, Registration number(s) required for booking of site.
- All bookings null and void after 7pm on day of booked arrival unless prior arranged.
- Site booking includes the use of Toilet and showers. Shower and toilets to be left in a clean and tidy condition.
- **Amenities** Code is not to be disclosed under any circumstances, any campers found leaving the shower door open or opening it for non-paying campers will be asked to leave.
- Power – 1 point per site – extra fee of \$5 per extra point applies. Gas fixtures must have current compliance certificate.
- Water consumption – Personal use only (restrictions apply) car and caravan washing prohibited.
- **Speed limit of 10klm/hr.** within grounds. Road rules are enforced throughout the grounds (this includes Alcohol/drugs driving regulations)
- Pets (maximum 2 dogs) – Pet Policy to be adhered to. Dogs must be always on a controlled lead, unless in Off leash designated area – please clean up after your dogs.
- Fires – **Currently No fires are allowed on the grounds.**
- Noise – to be kept at an acceptable level. 10pm to 6am council noise regulations enforced.
- Dump point – to be used in the correct manner and to be left in clean and safe condition.
- Alcohol – consumption is to be contained within caravan or annex area.
- Maintenance – Any repairs and maintenance to be carried out on grounds (DYI – maintenance use of electrical tools that must meet standard safety requirements) needs to be approved by caretaker.
- **NO DRONES-1 WARNING THEN EVICTION**
- Covid – current QLD COVID regulations must be always adhered to.
