CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1 - AGE TO BE TAKEN AS AT 1ST JUNE 2024
- 2 - ALL ENTRIES TO BE REGISTERED OR ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THE HERD BOOK OF THE RESPECTIVE BREED SOCIETY.
- 3 - ALL CATTLE MUST BE ON GROUND NO LATER THAN 7.15 AM SATURDAY
- 4 - ALL BULLS OVER 12 MONTHS MUST BE LED WITH A NOSE RING, ALL OTHER CATTLE MUST BE LED WITH NOSE GRIPS.
- 5 - NO STUD BEEF CATTLE TO BE ADMITTED TO THE GROUND UNLESS THOROUGHLY TRACTABLE AND DISEASE FREE
- 6 - ALL CATTLE TO REMAIN ON THE GROUNDS UNTIL AFTER SUB CHAMBER REGIONAL FINALS OR PRIZE MONEY IS FORFEITED.
- 7 - ANY ANIMAL SHOWN AS AN INDIVIDUAL EXHIBIT MAY NOT BE SHOWN WITH ITS DAM.
- 8 - ALL LEADS AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT TO BE TESTED AND TAGGED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAFETY REGULATIONS.
- 9 - ALL EXHIBITORS MUST CARRY OWN PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE.
- 10 - PLEASE BRING OWN FEED, WATER CONTAINERS AND HOSES FOR WASH BAY.
- 11 - THERE WILL BE NO ON GROUND SPRAYING FACILITIES DUE TO BIOSECURITY LAW CHANGES.
- 12 - JUDGING OF BREEDS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS - DROUGHTMASTERS WILL BE JUDGED SEPARATELY IN RING 1, ALL OTHER BREEDS WITH ENTRY NUMBERS UNDER 20 HEAD WILL BE JUDGED IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CATEGORIES - TROPICAL, BRITISH, EUROPEAN AND SMALL BREEDS.

F - Young judges/handlers who are eligible for regional sub chamber finals are not eligible for this event.
